4th SOUTH DELHI SHOTGUN SHOOTING COMPETITION

(TRAP/SKEET): 6th to 8th October 2023 Last date to apply: 28th September 2023

We are pleased to announce that the 4th, South Delhi Shotgun Shooting Competition will be held at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Tughlaqabad, New Delhi from **Friday**, **6**th **October to Sunday**, **8**th **October 2023** for Trap and Skeet shotgun events. This competition is being organized in association with the Delhi State Rifle Association (DSRA).

All the participants are requested to go through the following terms and conditions for participating in this competition:

- 1. The competition is open to all interested shooters, irrespective of membership of any Shooting Association.
- 2. Participants will be registered on first-come first-served basis.
- 3. The competition will be conducted under supervision of observers nominated by Delhi State Rifle Association.
- 4. The category of the matches is based on age of the participant, as on 6th October 2023.
- 5. The competition would be conducted in both NR and ISSF category matches. Shooters who have earlier participated in any ISSF category match of any particular event either in State Shooting Competitions or Zonal or at Nationals are not permitted to participate in NR category match of that particular event in this competition, they will need to participate only in ISSF Category matches as NR matches are for beginners / new shooters.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

The registration process will be ONLINE only and is as follows

- 1.2. Fill in the Entry Form on the webpage
- 1.3. You will receive an email and SMS on successful completion of your registration along with a Competitor ID.

OTHER RULES

- 1. The matches will be conducted broadly based on NRAI Match Book and organizers reserve the right to alter any rule for the smooth conduct of the competition.
- 2. The minimum age for participation for firearms events is 12 years. Shooters below the age of 21 years (i.e. born on or after 06-10-2002) will be considered as Junior category shooters. A Self Attested copy of NRAI Shooter I.D. / Municipal Birth Certificate must be submitted in case of Junior Shooters.
- 3. Junior category shooters can participate in both Junior and Senior category.
- 4. The last date for submission of entry is 28th September 2023 after which late entry may be accepted on payment of Double Entry Fee.
- 5. Each shooter will shoot 5 rounds of total 125 targets.
- 6. Documents to be submitted with the Entry Form:
 - Address Proof/SDDRA/DSRA Membership Card (in case of valid Members)
 - Additionally, for Juniors Category shooters- Copy of Birth Certificate/NRAI Shooter ID.
- 7. Entry fee: ₹ 5000/- only per match. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries, the Entry Fee is non-refundable, except in the event of the match being cancelled.
- 8. The venue and timing of Prize Distribution ceremonies will be put up on the notice board. Medals will be awarded for all categories. Participation Certificates will be issued to all shooters on request.
- 9. Cash prizes will be given to top shooters in finals of Trap and Skeet
- 10. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time, at its sole discretion, for the event and any such decision made would be final and binding. Submission of the filled Entry

Form/Fee by a Shooter confirms acceptance of all conditions.

- 11. Shooters have to make their own arrangements for all shooting equipment (gun, ammunition, etc.).
- 12. Juniors can also participate in senior category with payment of additional entry fee as per rules.
- 13. All Participants must agree to and strictly follow COVID-19 protocols. VIOLATION OF COVID PROTOCOLS MAY LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION FROM THE COMPETITION.
- 14. Coaches / Shooting Clubs or Groups who submit group entries of 6 or more shooters shall be eligible for the Dr. R. C. MANGLA CUP Rolling Trophy along with a Memento, based on merit on combined average team score of TOP 6 of their shooters, irrespective of their gender or ages. All team entries must be submitted before the last date.
